

Clackamas Tournament Rules

1. All JBO rules apply in addition to the below rules.

2. Game cards need to be picked up before each game and returned filled out after each game. Home Team is responsible for filling out and returning game cards. During Saturday pool play the home team is determined by coin flip with team that traveled farthest calling the flip. Coin flip winner picks home or away. Sunday the better seeded team chooses home or away.

3. Pitching

Seniors Levels: A player cannot pitch more than six (6) total innings per consecutive games (One day to the next is not considered consecutive games). In addition, a player is limited to four (4) innings per game. Maximum number of innings allowed during the weekend is eighth (8) innings.

Junior Levels: A player cannot pitch more than five (5) total innings per consecutive games (One day to the next is not considered consecutive games). In addition, a player is limited to three (3) innings per game. The maximum number of innings allowed during the weekend is seven (7) innings.

Minor Levels: A player cannot pitch more than four (4) total innings per consecutive games (One day to the next is not considered consecutive games). In addition, a player is limited to three (3) innings per game. Maximum number of innings allowed during the weekend is six (6) innings.

Any pitcher that throws one (1) pitch in an inning is considered to throw one (1) inning.

4. All games have a 2 hour DROP DEAD time limit (no new inning after 1 hour 50 min). Only Exception: Sunday final bracket Championship games. A new inning starts immediately once the 3rd out is made at the end of the previous inning.

5. Run Rules

Senior and Junior Levels:

12 after 3 innings

10 after 4 innings

8 after 5 innings

Minor Levels

12 after 3 innings

10 after 4 innings

6. No game will end in a tie. At the end of a game (due to time limit) revert back to the last complete inning that one team was ahead. If not possible a coin flip determines winner with home team calling flip.
7. To move teams from pool to bracket play tie breakers are, in order: 1 Head to head, 2. Run differential (total run differential for 2 games with a 10-run max differential per game), 3. Total runs allowed (for 2 games), 4. If still tied a coin flip with a better seeded team calling flip.
